SITE DESCRIPTION:

A fine small scale Federation style house in the main street with a projecting gabled wing finished in pressed metal panels and overhanging the bay window. The verandah is bull-nosed and has a timber patterned valence and decorative end infill. The house is set in a good garden with a new well detailed picket fence.

HISTORY:

Built as a house in around 1908 by George Quinn's father.

BOUNDARY:

The listing boundary is formed by the title boundary of the property and forms part of the wider, Gordon St, conservation precinct.

COMMENTS:

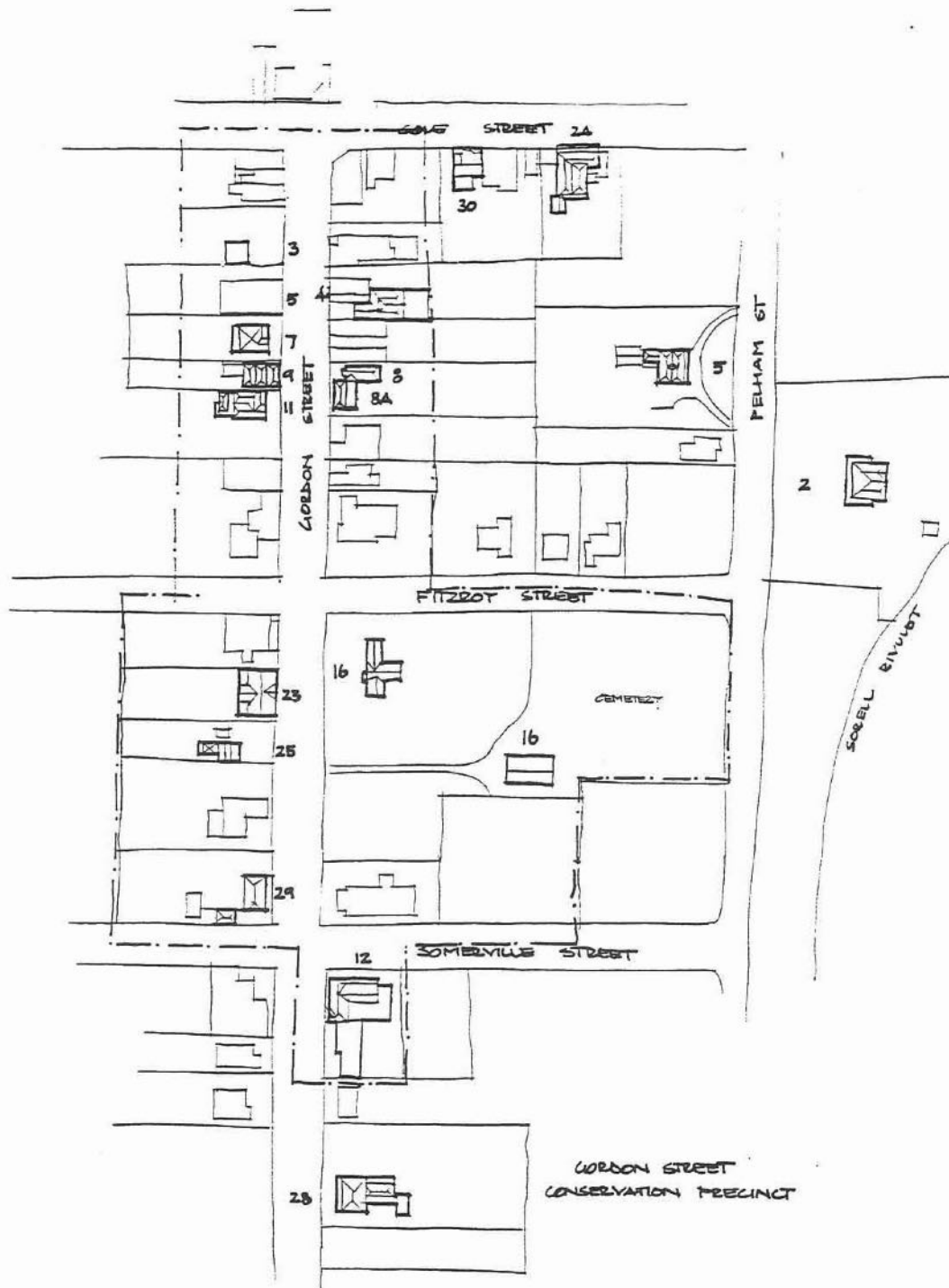
A fine example of late Federation architecture that contributes to the main streetscape of the town.
