SITE DESCRIPTION:

A fine small scale Federation style house in the main street with a projecting gabled wing to the front and an enclosed front verandah. There is a small addition to the side of no significance. The rear of the building is the most significant section retaining its formerly detached kitchen wing which is now connected with a skillion addition. This has a prominent rendered chimney and retains its early form and external detailing. This elevation will be of increasing significance as the redevelopment of the rear of these sites takes place for carparking and the rear elevations become a major focus of the site.

The listing boundary is formed by the title boundary of the property and forms part of the wider, Gordon St, conservation precinct.

COMMENTS:

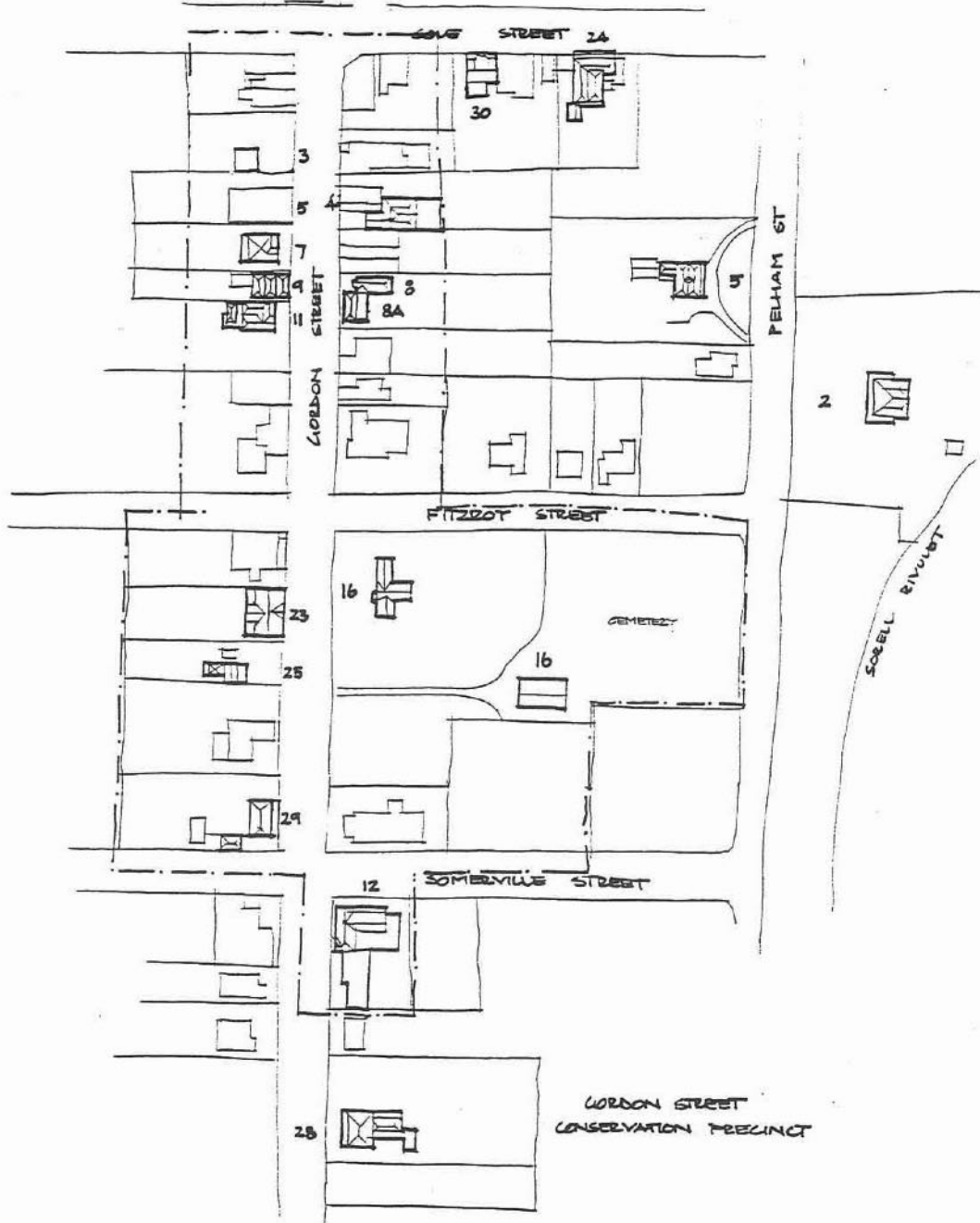
A fine example of late Federation architecture that contributes to the main streetscape of the town and which has a fine rear collection of now attached outbuildings.

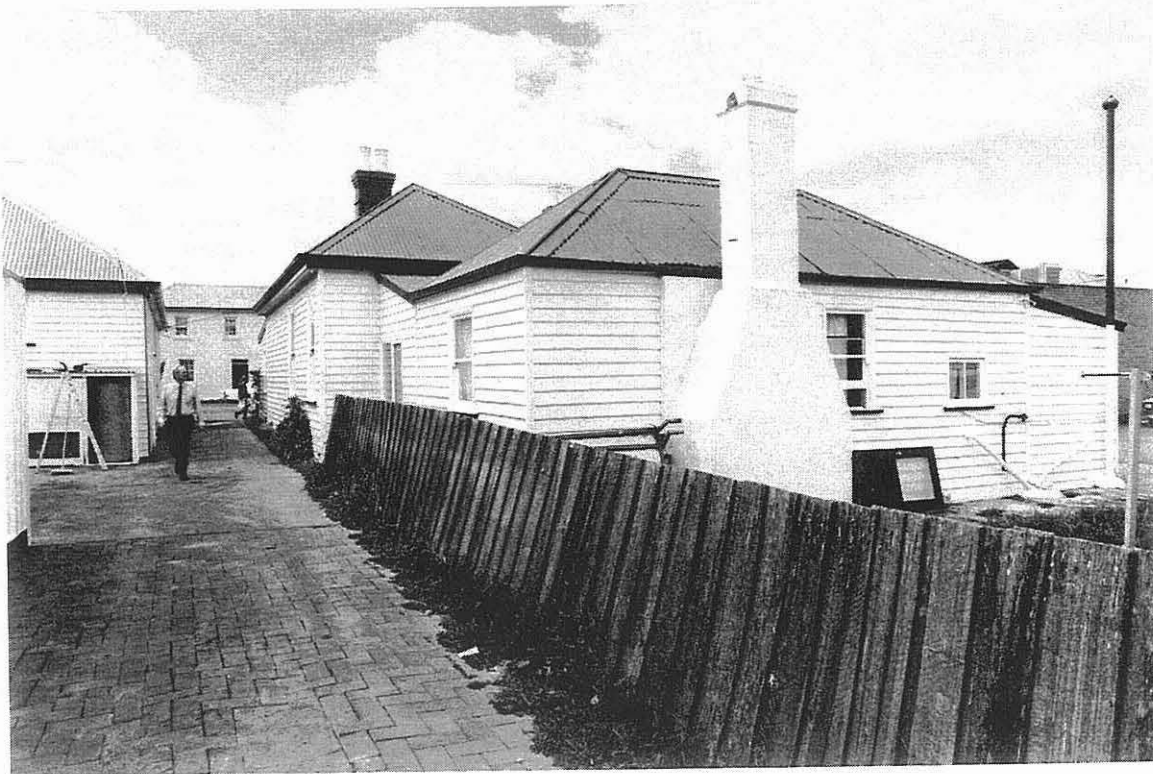
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
